

**Communication/Messages:** We use Remind to contact you for attendance, school cancellations and other important information. If your child is ill or has an appointment, please inform the office and the teacher first thing <u>each</u> morning by sending a text through remind. Reminder: Students are not allowed to use their cell phone during school hours. Please use Remind to message their teacher (they will check for messages at break times).

**School Safety Patrols:** Our school safety patrols work hard to help students cross safely. Parents please set a good example by using crosswalks and encouraging children to do the same. Thanks for your cooperation!

Parking... Just a reminder to our LCS families - please be careful not to park too close to our neighbour's driveways. We want to be good neighbours in our community, and ensure we are not infringing on their ability to enter/exit their properties. There is NO PARKING permitted on the street in front of the school buildings (including north of the west campus to the corner as bus drivers wait there to be lined up in the proper order for students) between 3:25 and 3:45 as this is dismissal time with buses coming in. Also, any vehicles parked on school property are not allowed to move until ALL buses have left. Please do not drive over pylons or move them to exit. Due to Fire Regulations, No double parking on West Campus by gymnasium. Also, please use crosswalks, no crossing between buses! Thank you for following these guidelines for the safety of all our children.
