



Nurturing Children



This is the season of Advent; the time of the arrival of the Christ. During this month, many will reflect on the promises of His coming that we can read about throughout the Old Testament and celebrate His birth that we read of in the Gospels. We see God's promises of nurturing throughout the Old Testament, especially in books like Isaiah, a book full of Messianic promise. God tells us that "as a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you" (Isaiah 66:13). And we see that Comfort come in the form of our Lord Jesus Christ, our Immanuel, God with us. He "did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant" (Philippians 2:6-7). Our Lord became flesh, wrapped in swaddling cloths, laid in a manger - a child, nurtured by His mother, preparing for His sacrifice to truly save and nurture us.

At Lacombe Christian School, part of our vision states that we will "strive to nurture ... children to be Spirit-filled disciples of Christ." We promise to care for the growth and development of each of your children that God places in our school. We cherish these children and hope to grant each of them encouragement in their walk with God. As Jesus said to His disciples, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these" (Matthew 19:14). We strive to follow this command: to nurture, not hinder His children, preparing them for kingdom service.

School Updates

The past month has been a busy one. Teachers and students have been working hard in their courses as Term 1 has been wrapping up. Report cards are going out December 1, with Parent Teacher Interviews scheduled for December 3 and 4. Our teachers are looking forward to connecting with parents in this important way. In addition to this, November is usually a month of reports. Funding items need to go out, audits from last year are finished up, combined Boards meet for governance training, and the Alberta Education Results Report is completed as part of our accountability to the Province of Alberta. We've had a few bigger events in November too. This past week, we had a homeschool group present a play to our K-6 students. The "Fish Tales" presentation was well received. This is a great initiative to help our students (and parents and teachers) develop positive habits around technology. A Reminder about the East Campus Security System...

The East Campus (Playschool - Gr. 3) has a security system on the front doors with a code needed to access the building during school hours. If you need entry, please request the code from the office. We ask that you do not share this code. Parents must escort their child(ren) to the door to ensure they gained entry, we do not want our little ones to be locked out!

PARKING: Drop off & Pick up: There is NO PARKING permitted on the street directly in front of the school buildings before and after school as buses will be coming in. We recommend parking on the East or South side of the East campus playground when picking up children. Please DO NOT block or park too closely to driveways (Bylaw says 1.5m or 5 feet). We want to be good neighbours in our community and ensure we are not blocking them from entering/exiting their properties. Also, any vehicles parked on school property are not allowed to move until ALL buses have left. Please DO NOT move the traffic cones. They are put there for student safety. Also, no double parking on the West Campus by the gym, use parking stalls.

Communication/Messages: We use Remind to contact you for attendance, school cancellations & other important information. If your child is ill or has an appointment, please inform the office & the teacher first thing each day using Remind. Students are not allowed their phones during school hours, please message their teacher (who will check for messages at break times).


